



Program Descriptions:

Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) Programs:

Permanent Housing with support services including comprehensive, client-centered case management, benefits assistance and linkages to mental health, counseling and other clinical services, as well as linkages to other community supports. For chronically homeless single adults.

Hands Across Long Island (HALI) Home At Last PSH will serve Nassau and Suffolk residents. Sites will be located in Town of Islip.

Spin the Yard will serve Suffolk residents. Sites will be located in Town of Babylon.

Transitional- to Rapid Rehousing (TH-RRH) Programs:

Transitional Housing is immediate, short-term housing for individuals. It is intended to be very short-term, and include intensive supports to assist participants access Rapid Rehousing for more stability. Rapid Rehousing includes medium-term, shallow rental subsidies and intensive supports intended to help households strengthen their stability so they can remain in permanent housing after the services and subsidy end. Supports include assistance obtaining and maintaining benefits and/or employment, linkages to clinical services, budgeting assistance, linkages to community supports.

Green Door Management Transitional Housing will serve Nassau residents. Sites will be located in Nassau County.

Spin the Yard TH-RRH will serve Suffolk residents. The Transitional Housing will be located in the Town of Brookhaven, and the RRH will be located in scattered sites throughout Suffolk County.

Street Outreach:

Crisis, survival and housing-focused street outreach with comprehensive support services including assistance obtaining/maintaining benefits, linkages to clinical services and referrals to permanent housing. Teams will primarily serve different jurisdictions.

Hands Across Long Island Street Outreach program will serve Nassau and Suffolk Counties.

Long Island Coalition for the Homeless Services for Unsheltered Individuals will serve Nassau and Suffolk Counties.

CN Guidance Street Outreach program will serve Nassau County

Maureen's Haven Outreach program will serve the east end of Suffolk County.

Planning Grant:

Coordination of new programs, monitoring and review, training for providers, assistance in facilitation of COC, Governance Board, Street Outreach and PLE committees; coordination of annual homeless count, submission of unsheltered NOFO.

Long Island Coalition for the Homeless' Planning grant will serve Nassau and Suffolk Counties.
